To Provide a compliance guide to consumers and dealers as to which Low-E Insulation products qualify for federal Tax Credits under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

Under Section 25 C and 25 D of the Internal Revenue Code, homeowners can receive a 30 % (up to \$1500.00 total) credit on the cost of "qualified energy Efficiency improvements". Tax credits apply to improvements made to a primary residence from Jan 17, 2009-Dec 31, 2010.
